Mary Ball Washington was an extraordinary woman whose influence extended far beyond being George Washington's mother. A trailblazer, she was an independent thinker, orphan, entrepreneur, widow, and single mother who faced life's challenges with resilience. Her strength shaped her son and the Washington legacy, inspiring generations. Her story remains timeless, reminding us that courage and perseverance never fade. By growing the stories of the Washington family, we honor their enduring impact.



Mary Washington Monument was dedicated on May 10, 1894, more than 100 years after Congress declared that a monument be raised in Mary Ball Washington's honor as *America's First Mother*. The site includes a favorite spot of Mary's, Meditation Rock and The Caretaker's Lodge, built in 1895.

Mary Washington House, purchased by George Washington in 1772 for his mother, served as her residence for the last 17 years of her life until her passing from breast cancer in 1789.

Rising Sun Tavern structure was built for Mary's youngest son, Charles Washington around 1760 as his home. The house became a tavern for weary travelers in 1792 when it was purchased by the Wallace family.

Hugh Mercer Apothecary Shop portrays the medical practice of Dr. Mercer, who served the citizens of Fredericksburg, including Mary Washington, with medicines and treatments of the time. The building was built in 1772.

St. James' House was built in 1768 as the home of attorney James Mercer, who drew up the will for Mary Washington. The house was built on land once owned by Fielding Lewis, brother-in-law of George Washington.
